# 29. Hard work





A lazy man is stupid, not because of lack of intellectual capacity but just because of his laziness. He doesn't understand that laziness will destroy his life and deprive him of all the good things he desires.



Every field we put our effort into and start to work on will begin to yield fruit, but the one neglected will be overgrown.

The bible says – Prov 24:30-34 (NKJV)

"I went by the field of the lazy man, and by the vineyard of the man devoid of understanding; and there it was, all overgrown with thorns; its surface was covered with nettles; its stone wall was broken down. When I saw it, I considered it well; I looked on it and received instruction: a little sleep, a little slumber, a little folding of the hands to rest; so shall poverty some like a prowler, and your need like a armed man"







The goal of having a trouble-free life is not a vision, but a neglect of the talents and opportunities God has given us.

Often the lack of vision is the reason to laziness. A lazy person is a person without true vision for his/her life.
